Hanover Displays is concerned that the trade of conflict minerals mined in the eastern provinces of the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) or adjoining countries may be fuelling human rights atrocities and armed conflict in the region.

These minerals and their refined metals, tantalum, tin, tungsten and gold are widely used in the manufacture of electronic products.

We fully support the actions of governments and organizations to increase supply chain transparency and enable companies to source conflict-free minerals.

We are committed to showing diligence in this area by communicating regularly with the relevant suppliers to ensure that we continue to only source materials from them containing conflict-free minerals.

At present we have contacted and received declarations from all our applicable tier one suppliers confirming that the materials we source from them are free of conflict minerals
